The BM3162 Chair, also known as the School Chair, is a Danish modern from 1958, designed by the renowned Danish furniture designers and architects Børge Mogensen and Esben Klint - reimagined in upcycled waste materials by Mater.

The BM3162 Chair is a part of Mater's Børge Mogensen *Conscious Collection* and the first collection from Børge Mogensen that has been relaunched in a different material than the original.

The seat and backrest of the BM3162 Chair is made from waste materials - moulded from a mix of discarded coffee shells or wood fibres from furniture production mixed with recycled industrial plastic waste all from large scale companies wastestreams.

The base of the chair is crafted from solid FSC® certified oak or beech wood, the label for responsible forestry, which means the wood comes from responsibly managed forests.
