- To reduce the risk of strangulation, wiring should be effectively fixed to the wall. Avoid trailing cable to prevent trip hazards and keep out of reach of children.

Cleaning instructions

- Wipe surface of the shade with a soft dry cloth.
- Do not use any abrasive cleaning tools such as steel wool, scouring sponges or stiff brushes.
- Never use strong cleaning agents such as white spirit, turpentine, household glass cleaner or cellulose thinners.


Tools needed

- Bulb type E14

Please follow steps 1 to 3 to assemble the product.


Step 1

Install lightbulb into lamp.



Step 2

Ensure the cord can be connected to a nearby power source so that it does not over-stretch or become an obstacle. Place the lamp in the desired location. Ensure the lamp is level and mark the placement of the holes with a pencil.



Step 3

Drill holes for the lamp and insert suitable plugs for both the selected wall type and provided screws. Match the holes in the lamp's base to the wall and insert srews before tightening and and ensuring the lamp is safely fixed.
